ORDER DECLARING INTEREST OF REMAINDER BENEFICIARIES

Pursuant to the Order of the Court, the Trustees, by and through their counsel, David Reese of Cooke, Roberts, and Reese, Ltd. And William Peterson of Morris, Pickering and Peterson; the Remainder Beneficiaries, Lorin, Lear, Vanessa Bertelli, Jennifer Lear, Valente Bertelli, Jesse Jackson, Luke Jackson, and Chloe Jackson, as remainder beneficiaries of the William Powell Lear Family Trust "B" (the "Trust"), by and through their counsel Bridget Robb Peck of Beesley, Peck & Mateoni, Ltd.; Shanda Lear-Baylor by and through her counsel Patrick James Martin; and Patrick Lear, acting in *propia persona*; filed simultaneous Briefs on March 27, 2006 and simultaneous Reply Briefs on April 6, 2006. The briefing was ordered to be confined to the issue of whether the Remainder Beneficiaries' interest in the Lear Family Trust was vested or contingent. Oral argument on the issue was heard by this Court on April 14, 2006, at which time the above-named parties appeared in *propia persona* or by and through their respective counsel listed above.

1 In the past this Court has considered the Remainder Beneficiaries as Contingent Beneficiaries

2 Based upon the Briefs submitted by the parties, the arguments of counsel and parties, and
3 all the papers, pleadings, and orders entered in this matter; and based upon the language of the
4 Lear Family Trust Agreement, the Court concludes that the better policy for Nevada law is the early
5 vesting of interests in a trust; henceforth and hereafter, good cause appearing,

6 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that the interest of the
7 Remainder Beneficiaries to the Lear Family Trust described in Article Fifth (b) therein as "lawful
8 issue", is declared to be vested subject to defeasance.
